We can never enter the kingdom of glory until the kingdom of grace has entered us. (5)

Vegetarian Chicken Enchiladas

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 8 oz. sour cream
- ¼ cup Mexican green taco sauce
- 1 can black olives, drained and chopped
- ½ pound cheddar cheese, grated
- 1 can FriChik, diced (keep the juice)
- 8-10 flour tortillas

PREPARATION:

1. Mix together all ingredients except cheese, tortillas, and FriChik juice.
2. Add some of the FriChik juice to the mixture until it seems creamy but not watery (you won't use it all).
3. Spread about ¼ of the mixture in a thin layer at the bottom of an 8 x 10 pan.

4. Using ½ the mixture, assemble and roll each enchilada as follows: In the center of each flour tortilla, add a large spoonful of the mixture, sprinkle with grated cheese, roll and place in pan.
5. When all tortillas are rolled and placed in the pan, top with the remaining sauce and cheese.
6. Bake at 350 degrees for 25-30 minutes.
