Baked Lentils with Cheese

Preheat oven to 375F

Combine in shallow 9"x13" baking dish:

- 1¾ c. lentils, rinsed
- 2 c. water
- 1 whole bay leaf
- 2 t. salt
- ¼ t. pepper
- ⅛ t. EACH marjoram, sage, thyme
- 2 large onions, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 c. canned tomatoes

Cover tightly and bake 30 minutes.

Uncover and stir in:

- 2 large carrots, sliced 1/8" thick
- ½ c. thinly sliced celery

Bake uncovered 40 minutes until vegetables are tender. Stir in:

- 1 green pepper chopped (optional)
- 2 T. finely chopped parsley

Sprinkle on top:

- 3 c. shredded cheddar cheese

Bake uncovered, 5 minutes until cheese melts.

Pumpkin chocolate chip cookies

- 1 box spice cake mix
- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 large (29 oz) can pumpkin
- 2 cups chocolate chips

Mix all together and spoon onto cookie sheet. Bake at 350F for 18-20 min.

Stepping out in faith

THE STORY OF THE Rich Young Ruler is found in Luke 18:18-25. Can you imagine the young man's reaction when Jesus put him to the test: "Sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor... and come, follow me." Was Jesus asking too much? Was the test too hard? Actually, each one of us may face a test—at some time in our lives—when Jesus asks us to "forsake all" and follow Him.

Think of how much Jesus sacrificed for our redemption. Perhaps it is some practice that we know is wrong; perhaps it is a job, some ad-

diction, some entertainment, some reading-material, or neglected duty that we feel we cannot change without personal loss or even financial disaster: If we clearly know that what we are doing is wrong, then God is asking us to step out in faith.—Make a total and unreserved commitment. We need to pray for power and the infilling of His Spirit to give us the needed strength and resolve. Then we must act, knowing that when doing His will, we can trust Him to deal with the consequences. (See James 4:17, 1Col 10:13, Luke 18:27-30)

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Home School Cooperative at Eastgate

AS MANY OF YOU know, I have been discussing the possibility of starting a home school group with the church board. One of my and the church board's primary concerns has been that we do not want such a program to detract in any way from our fabulous Adventist schools – Rogers, Milton-Stateline, and the WWU Preschool. Our church solidly supports Adventist

education and we will continue to do so. At the same time, we recognize that our church and our Valley has many home schooling families who would benefit greatly from a home school program. For that reason, we have decided to move forward with a home school cooperative, which we will re-evaluate at the end of each quarter. Fall quarter will start October 14th and go for 8

weeks. Classes will be multi-age for children 5-12 and will meet Tuesday afternoons 1:15-4:30. First quarter classes will include art, drama, choir and PE. We will have a program for our younger preschool children (mostly siblings of older children) that meets at the same time.
